## Welcome from the Manager & President

Dear Runestone Telecom Cooperative Members,

We are pleased to present the annual report for Runestone Telecom Association for the year ending 2023. This year, we have experienced significant growth and development as we continue to offer high-quality fiber optic facilities to our valued members. Our commitment to improving connectivity in rural areas remains unwavering, and we are proud of the progress we have achieved together.

Runestone Telecom received its sixth State of Minnesota Border-to-Border Broadband Grant in late June 2023. In early 2022, Stearns County officials contacted Runestone to inquire about using county and township funds as a portion of the local match for our grant application. With financial assistance from Stearns County and the State of Minnesota, the direct cost to Runestone is 30% of the original construction cost. The grant covers the area in western Stearns County south of Interstate 94 in Sauk Centre, west of U.S. Highway 71 to the western county line, and into the communities of Brooten and Belgrade. There are over six hundred locations in this project area with limited or no Internet access. The project will commence in July of this year.

Construction on our Herman - Dumont Grant area is complete, and we have connected 165 customers to the Runestone fiber network. Several of these are new customers, but approximately one-third of these are existing customers we have converted from the wireless system on the Herman water tower. There is still the potential for an additional two hundred accounts in this area.

Fiber to the Home (FTTH) construction in the City of Wheaton is complete. This project added over 250 new customers to the cooperative. As people fulfill their contracts with existing providers, we acquire additional subscribers.

The FTTH build in the communities of Cyrus, Donnelly, and Kensington is complete. The FTTH build-out in Hoffman will be finished in 2024. With this completion, we will have achieved our goal of providing FTTH to all members of the Cooperative.

Financially, Runestone had another fantastic year with Net Margins of \$4,836,597. There is a 9% increase in Internet customers, with 427 new accounts. A pricing change that no longer requires a phone line to receive a discount on our Internet service resulted in the discontinuation of 257 telephone lines. This line loss was expected, and we anticipate it will continue.

On behalf of the Board of Directors and Employees, we thank you for your patronage. We are proud of the progress we have made this year and are grateful for the support and trust of our members. Your feedback and participation are important to us, and we hope you can attend the 74th annual meeting for the members of Runestone Telecom Association which will be held at West Central Area Secondary School in Barrett on July 17th at 7:00 PM. We look forward to seeing you there.

# ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MEMBERS OF RUNESTONE TELECOM ASSOCIATION July 19, 2023

The members of Runestone Telecom Association held their 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting on July 19, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at the West Central School Auditorium in Barrett, MN, with President, Robert Leegaard and Secretary/Treasurer, John Kapphahn being present. Other directors in attendance were Tory Belgum, Richard Staples and Jolene Vipond.

President, Robert Leegaard, welcomed everyone to the 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting and thanked Ken Elvehjem for providing entertainment prior to the meeting.

A register signed by the members established the attendance of a sufficient number of members to constitute a quorum. The Secretary was directed to file the registration for the establishment of a quorum and make the same a part of the minutes of this meeting.

Secretary/Treasurer, John Kapphahn, read the Affidavit of Publication of Notice of Annual Meeting. President Leegaard then asked for a motion to approve the Affidavit and the 2022 Annual Meeting Minutes as presented in the 2022 Annual Report. General Manager/CEO, Kent Hedstrom, presented the 2022 financial statement along with updates on fiber to the home projects and Border-to-Border grants, ACAM support, membership growth, and directorship member representation. A motion was made by Eileen Olson, seconded by David Hedner, and carried to accept the financial statements as presented.

The Tellers for the Annual Meeting, Dianne Johnson and Elaine Nelson were introduced and thanked for their service.

The results of the proposed Articles of Incorporation and By-Law Proposals were announced. Proposal: Formation of Districts, Election Schedule for Board of Directors Representation and Clarification of Director Qualifications passed with 721 For, 13 Against and 3 Spoiled.

There was no old or new business to come before the meeting.

The Runestone directors and employees were introduced and door prizes were given out.

The members were then invited to stay for brownies, treats, and ice cream served by some of the West Central Area Trap Shooting students.

A motion was made by Archie Moeller, seconded and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 p.m.
